Did you know that students have different learning styles?

Auditory learners prefer listening to explanations and may study by reading information aloud. They may want to have background music while studying, or they may be distracted by noises and need a quiet space to study.

Kinesthetic learners learn by doing and touching. They understand information better by writing it down or doing hands-on activities. They may have trouble sitting still while studying.

Visual learners process new information by reading, looking at graphics, or watching a demonstration. They can grasp information presented in a chart or graph, but they may grow impatient listening to an explanation.
